The Problem

Diaper need is the struggle to provide a sufficient number of clean diapers to ensure that each diaper user can be changed out of wet or soiled diapers as often as necessary. An adequate supply of diapers is a basic need for all infants, as necessary for health and well-being, as food and shelter.

The Effects

1

Physical Health

Without enough diapers children experience severe diaper rashes, Urinary Tract Infections and visit urgent care/pediatrician more often.

2

Early Learning

87% of Florida Childcare providers require parents to provide their own diapers in order for their child to attend early learning opportunities.

3

Mental Health

Parents experiencing diaper need felt alone, judged, or helpless for having diaper need. Diaper Need is also linked to maternal depression.

Without government assistance programs to help low-income and families stricken by poverty, with diapers, thousands of families rely on our safety net program to make ends meet. **However, basics are often overlooked and under-funded.**

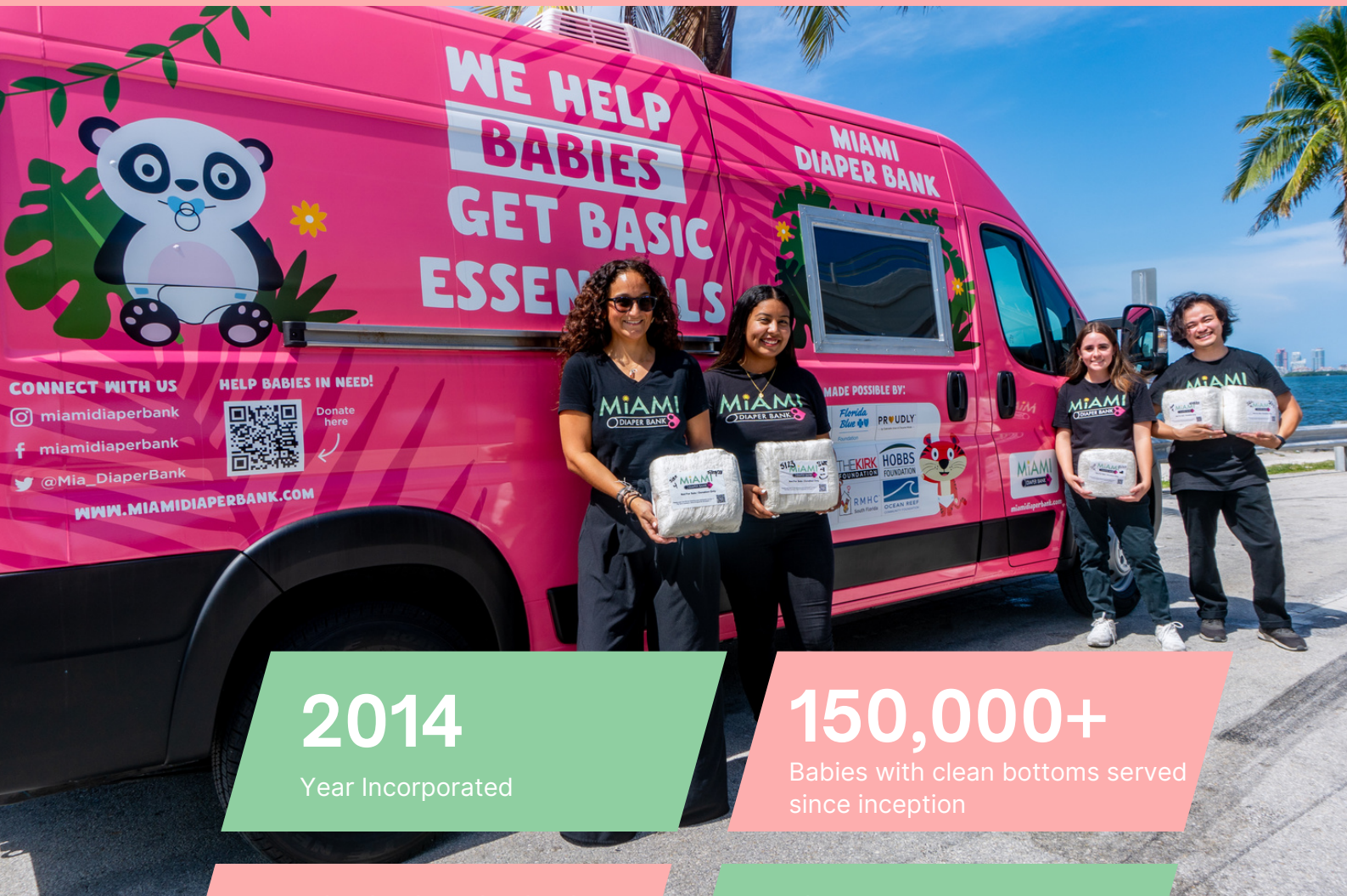

Core Partners

Miami Diaper Bank partners with local agencies like Lotus House, Genesis Hopeful Haven, Families First of Palm Beach, Miami - Broward and Florida Keys Healthy Start Coalitions, ICU Baby, Overtown Youth Center, and others, to serve the most at need/at-risk families. When we partner with local agencies, they are able to shift their funds from purchasing high cost retail diapers, to other program needs like food, parenting classes, early learning vouchers and family empowerment resources.

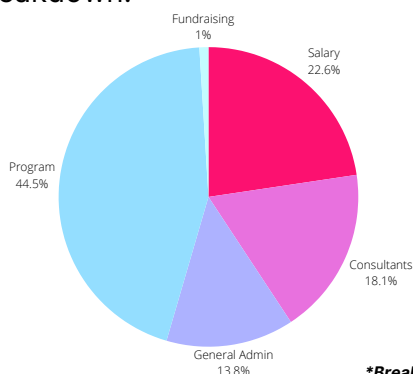

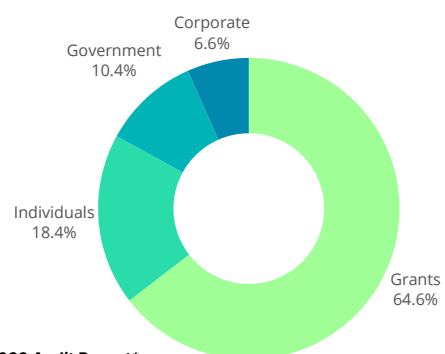
Fiscal Responsibility
